



Artist Parking Information:

Unfortunately, the Old Town Art Fair is unable to provide parking to Exhibitors and has no jurisdiction over fees charged by area lots. None of the lots take advance reservations. We suggest the following options:

- LaSalle Language Academy school lot – 1734 N. Orleans St., entrance on Orleans between Eugenie and Willow. The lot is operated as a school fundraiser. It is the closest lot to the Fair. Single spaces are \$100 for the weekend (\$200 for larger vehicles needing two spaces). Access to the lot begins after 5:30 p.m. Friday. After load in, artist cars may park temporarily on the streets around the school lot or in the Buddhist Temple lot until 5:30.
- The Midwest Buddhist Temple lot – 435 W. Menomonee Street. The parking lot is behind the Temple and is reached via North Avenue. From North Ave., go one block west of the traffic light at Sedgwick Street to Hudson Ave. and turn north on Hudson. At the end of the second block, enter the Midwest Buddhist Temple parking lot. Single spaces are \$100 for the weekend (\$200 for larger vehicles needing two spaces and those arriving earlier than Friday).
- Chicago History Museum lot – 1692 N. Stockton Dr., entrance is on Stockton Dr. near the Clark/LaSalle intersection (no oversized trucks or trailers).
- 1349 N. North Park Ave. – open-air, paved lot at North Park and Schiller, approximately one-half mile south of the Fair.
- Parking on metered streets (such as Clark Street): Use the parkchicago.com/ app to pay and refresh parking meter fees.
- spothero.com, parkwhiz.com, or parkingpanda.com/chicago/parking – online parking search and reservation websites/apps that may help locate parking in the Old Town area. Rates are usually discounted.

Please note the following:

- Fair streets will be closed to parking starting Friday at 9:00 a.m. Towing of cars left on Fair streets will begin Friday morning.
- Parking in alleys is strictly prohibited.
- Nearby streets outside the Fair footprint require a permit for overnight street parking. A limited number of permits for street parking may be available at artist check-in.
- All of these parking options are accessed by city streets or have limited space. For this show, we suggest you do not bring large vehicles with trailers.
